  - introducing new people to bluebirds and other native cavity nesting birds and helping them get started with a trail;
    - making presentations to youth and adults;
    - working with schools to present programs relating to bluebird and habitat conservation for all native cavity nesting birds;
    - acting as a liaison or support person for NABS or a local/state/provincial organization to assist

with handling queries or problems folks have on their trails.
